EXCHANGE STUDENTS

You can choose your courses (please refer to our course outline) and present your subject choices to the Grenoble Law School International Relations Office (IRO) and your home institution IRO.

You have also the possibility to study for two university certificates at the Grenoble Law School : the Diplôme de Droit Français (a university diploma with courses in French) or the Diploma in Legal Studies (fully taught in English).

Take advantage of one full year study (two semesters - 60 ECTS), apply through our web-site and at the same time have a look at our multicultural environment and many facilities, and free tuition fees...

DIPLOMA IN LEGAL STUDIES

A high-quality degree taught in small groups which can be considered by your home university as part of your degree. Up to 15 dedicated lecturers are involved in this programme.

Before applying, you must have completed two years of a law degree or another degree with connections to law.



NON EXCHANGE STUDENTS

For non-exchange students your acceptance to our university depends on your academic history and application dossier. You will be asked for an English proficiency certificate.
